Tar Remover is a revolutionary new solvent for removing tar, asphalt, road oil and grease from road equipment, vehicles, storage tanks and machinery.

When using **Tar Remover** to remove tar and road oil from equipment, it is important that the equipment be out of direct sunlight. Hot metal surfaces should always be hosed down with water before applying **Tar Remover**.

Do not allow the **Tar Remover** to dry on the surface, but hose away with water after it has dissolved the tar and other soil. If used according to directions **Tar Remover** will not streak painted surfaces in good condition. Very heavy encrustations may require a second application.

For food plant and other industrial use, avoid contamination of food in the application and storage of the product. Do not use in food handling areas.
