GENERAL INFORMATION:

United 411 SUPERSTEAM is designed to pass out of the boiler with the steam to protect all components of the steam and return system — lines, traps, tanks and pumps — against rust, corrosion and pitting.

- Safely neutralizes acidic condensate.
- Keeps radiators, convectors and unit heaters at full heating capacity.
- Prevents leaks leading to expensive repairs to lines concealed inside walls.
- Prevents corrosion of traps, returnlines and pumps.
- Saves on replacement of piping, traps, tanks and pumps.
- Low-cost insurance against costly replacements due to hidden corrosion.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

United 411 is best injected into the feedwater line between the final check valve and the boiler. A metering pump controlled by the feedwater pump control circuit is best. United's A603 pump is recommended, offering a range of delivery rates. **United 411** may also be added by pot feeder or into the feedwater (condensate return) tank.

INITIAL DOSAGE: Add one quart of **United 411** for every 2,000 gallons (1 litre for every 8,000 litres) of estimated boiler capacity.

MAINTENANCE DOSAGE: Feed enough **United 411** to maintain the condensate water pH in the range 7.5 - 8.5.
