United 354 is formulated for use in steam and extractor type carpet shampoo equipment and rotary shampoo machines. Safe for use on all fabrics that will not shrink or fade.

DIRECTIONS:

Remove all possible furniture. Vacuum rug thoroughly to remove all loose surface soil. Place wax paper or aluminum foil under legs of furniture that cannot be removed, to prevent rust spots from forming. Do not allow shampooer to rest on carpet; always move shampooer off the carpet or place a plastic mat under it while refilling tank, or performing operations away from the shampoo equipment.

PRE-SPOTTING: Heavily soiled spots should be pre-spotted before shampooing. For water soluble stains, use 5 ounces of **United 354** in a quart (150 mL per litre) of water and brush this solution into the spot. For oil, grease, tar and similar stains, **United 180 SOLV-ALL** should be used, according to the label directions.

STEAM AND EXTRACTOR TYPE SHAMPOOERS: For lightly soiled carpets, mix 2 to 4 ounces of **United 354** with every gallon of water (15 to 30 mL per litre). For heavier soil and traffic areas, use 6 to 10 ounces with every gallon of water (45 to 80 mL per litre).

ROTARY SHAMPOO MACHINE (Follow Manufacturer's Instructions For Machine Operation):

1. Mix shampoo concentrate with tap or moderately warm water: Light soil — mix 4 ounces of **United 354** with every gallon of water (30 mL per litre. Heavy soil — mix 6 ounces of **United 354** with every gallon of water (45 mL per litre.)
2. Pour mixed solution into machine shampoo tank and shampoo in a circular motion. Release enough shampoo to just cover the carpet pile. Do not build excess shampoo suds. Do not soak the carpeting.
3. Shampoo heavily soiled areas again without releasing additional shampoo by returning over lap and brushing only.
4. Pick up wet shampoo with an industrial vacuum if available; however, it is not necessary.
5. After shampooing approximately 100 sq. ft. (10 sq. m) and while the pile is still wet, brush the pile in one direction to avoid streaks or shading and to insure even drying and appearance (average drying time is 2 to 5 hours).
6. Place wax paper or special rust preventative material under legs of furniture to prevent rust spots until carpet is thoroughly dry.
7. Never allow a wet brush to rest on the carpet or rug. Always place a cardboard or heavy cloth under the brush.

United 354 is low foam and normally no defoamer will be necessary in the recovery tank.*

***NOTE:** Very often carpets will contain residues of high foam type shampoos. As the rug is shampooed, **United 354** will remove these old dried chemicals from the carpet and may cause foaming. In this event, use a capful of United 353 Defoamer Concentrate for each gallon (4 litre) of water in the recovery tank.
