DRAIN MAINTAINER

United 631 used in a weekly drain maintenance program will keep drains free running and sanitary. Weekly, add 3 to 4 ounces (90 to 130 mL) of **United 631** to each drain. Let stand for 5-10 minutes, and then flush drain with hot water for 2 or 3 minutes. If drain is slow running, repeat the regular maintenance dose every two or three days until drain is free running.

When using a metering pump with this product, you must use Viton® tubing.

GARBAGE AND REFUSE HAULERS

United 631 is the ideal cleaner for garbage trucks, dumpsters, refuse cans and garbage dumps. Mix 1 part **United 631** with 30-35 parts warm water. Spray the solution on dirty and odorous surfaces. Let stand for 2-3 minutes. If necessary, agitate surface with a stiff bristle brush and then hose off with clean water.
