DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

Dilute **United 217** with 1 to 10 parts of water, depending upon soil and scale to be removed. Solutions of **United 217** may be applied by brush, spray or as a dip tank solution. Allow solutions to remain in contact with the surface to be cleaned until soil is loosened, then rinse thoroughly with water. Usually 3 to 10 minutes will be sufficient to loosen soil and scale.

DISHWASHING MACHINES: Apply **United 217** 1/2 to full strength. Allow contact with surfaces to be cleaned for 5 to 10 minutes and then run machine through 2 rinse cycles.

STEAM TABLES: To safely remove hard water deposits and scale that accumulate on steam tables, apply **United 217** at 1/2 to full strength. After contact time of 5 to 10 minutes, flush away with clean water.

GLASS AND DISH RINSE: When glasses, dishes, and flatware become dulled and spotted because of hard water deposits, wash in normal manner, then soak them in solution containing 8 to 10 oz. of **United 217** in each gallon of water. **United 217** will remove hard water scale and spots and restore original lustre to articles cleaned.

ACID RESISTANT PORCELAIN SINKS, LAVATORIES, TUBS, TILE WALLS AND FLOORS: Apply solution of 6 to 10 oz. of United 217 per gallon of water to surfaces to be cleaned, including chrome or steel fixtures. United 217 will remove the soap scum, hard water scale and rust safely, without etching or pitting.

POTS, PANS, COFFEE URNS, ETC.: Soak articles to be cleaned in solution of 6 to 10 oz. of United 217 per gallon of water. Soak for 10 to 15 minutes, then rinse articles thoroughly with clean water.

DAIRIES: Use **United 217** for removing milkstone from processing kettles and utensils. Use at dilutions necessary for removing the scale which will vary from application to application.

DRINKING FOUNTAINS, HOSPITAL EQUIPMENT: Use **United 217** for removing hard water deposits, scale and soils. Vary dilutions based on the type and amount of deposits.

WATER METERS AND FILTERS: Soak in undiluted United 217 until clean, then rinse with water.

ICE MAKERS: Use United 217 to remove scale and hard water deposits. Dilute with 5 to 10 parts of water to descale and maintain ice makers. When used as directed, United 217 will not harm nickel plated parts.

MODO DE USAR:

Rebaje el producto usando 1 parte de **United 217** a 10 partes de agua dependiendo en la acumulación de mugre y escamas de jabon que desea quitar. La solución puede ser aplicada con cepillo, rociador, o en cubeta remojando el trapo o esponja. Deje que el liquido remoje la area hasta que la mugre afloje, luego enjuague con agua. De 3-10 minutos es suficiente para soltar la mugre y escamas.

Food contact surfaces are to be rinsed with potable water after use of this product.
