



GENERAL INFORMATION:

United 53 Defoamer is a concentrated, Industrial silicone-based defoamer. Use **United 53 Defoamer** to knock down detergent foam in:

- Wastewater influent
- Wastewater effluent
- Wastewater aeration areas
- Chlorine contact chambers
- Spas, hydrotanks and decorative fountains
- Cooling tower and boiler descaling

United 53 Defoamer is non-corrosive, non-flammable, and non-toxic. **United 53 Defoamer** should <u>not be used for "chocolate"</u> <u>foam.</u> United 594 Slime and Grease Cutter is recommended for this problem.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

United 53 Defoamer is a concentrate and should be diluted with five to ten parts of water for spray application. Use a pump-up sprayer, such as the United A062 to apply to small areas. For larger areas, metered pumping equipment is satisfactory. **United 53** can also be dripped into influent wells.

As little as one half of one part per million of **United 53 Defoamer** is frequently sufficient to knock down detergent foam in wastewater aerators, tanks, streams, and holding ponds. To defoam decorative fountain displays that have been "soaped" by vandals, add one gallon of **United 53 Defoamer** per 100 gallons of capacity. This usage level may be adjusted depending on the amount of soap or detergent that has been dumped into the fountain.
