DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

United 981 LAGOON SHARKS are 8-ounce blocks designed to be easily thrown into a lagoon system by hand, directly into the areas where a sludge build up has occurred. In large lagoons a small boat may be needed to help disperse the blocks. The Sharks should be spread out with 1 placed in each 1500 square foot area to be treated. Treat once every 3 months or as needed.

EMERGENCY AND FIRST AID PROCEDURES:

EYES: Flush eyes with cool water for at least 15 minutes while keeping eyelids open. If irritation persists, seek medical attention

SKIN: Wash with soap and water. Launder clothing. If irritation or redness persists, seek medical attention.

INHALATION: Not applicable.
