
On Ledges or Pipes

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

For RATS or MICE...

Separate the Glue Traps along the scored hinges and place lengthwise, glue—side up, against walls or wherever rodents are known to travel. To attract rodents more quickly, place a peanut in the center of the trap.

RATS: place traps at 10 to 15 ft. intervals.

MICE: place traps at 5 to 6 ft. intervals. Check traps daily. Separate the Glue Traps and place where

Separate the Glue Traps and place where mice are found, such as in cabinets, pantries, under sinks, or by refrigerators.

SNAKES: same directions as rats and mice.

DO NOT expose to extreme heat or damp conditions.

In dusty areas, lean a board against the wall over the traps.

Glue Traps can be secured to beams and pipes with wires or nylon ties.

In case of accidental contact with adhesive, easy clean up with cooking oil or mineral spirits. Followed by washing with warm water and mild soap.

CAUTION – DO NOT place traps where birds or non–target animals may come in contact with adhesive.

CONTENTS: TWO (2) TRAPS

Accepted by the USDA for use in meat and poultry plants.
