

LABORATORIES

Chemically converts grease blockages into soap so waste can be flushed away with water. Normally, it will not cause any fumes when used according to directions.

SEWER LINES:

In a regular maintenance program, add two to five gallons of **United 699** per manhole each month. Best application times are when water flow is reduced. For lines where there is no noticeable flow, let the solvent remain in the line for five to ten minutes, and then flush with water. **United 699** saponifies and liquifies grease and scum, so they are easily disposed of through normal sewer usage.

United 699 is also useful as a lift station cleaner. **United 699** saponifies grease so it becomes soft soap and is easily dispersed into the water, and is removed when the pump actuates. The amount to use will depend upon the amount of grease to saponify. Normally, **United 699** will treat approximately TEN TIMES ITS OWN VOLUME that is, one gallon of **United 699** will treat ten gallons of grease waste.
